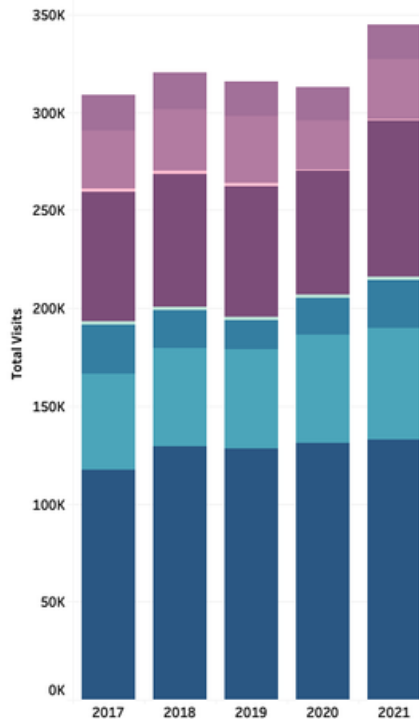

This report presents clinic utilization data from calendar years 2017 - 2021. Data was collected from the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) or was self-reported by clinics. Clinics include County Health Services Agency, County Mental Health Services, the Diabetes Health Center, Dientes Community Dental, Dominican Mobile Wellness Clinic, Planned Parenthood Mar Monte, Salud Para La Gente, and Santa Cruz Community Health.

19% From 2017 to 2021 patient visits in the safety net increased by over 19% (35,704 additional visits)

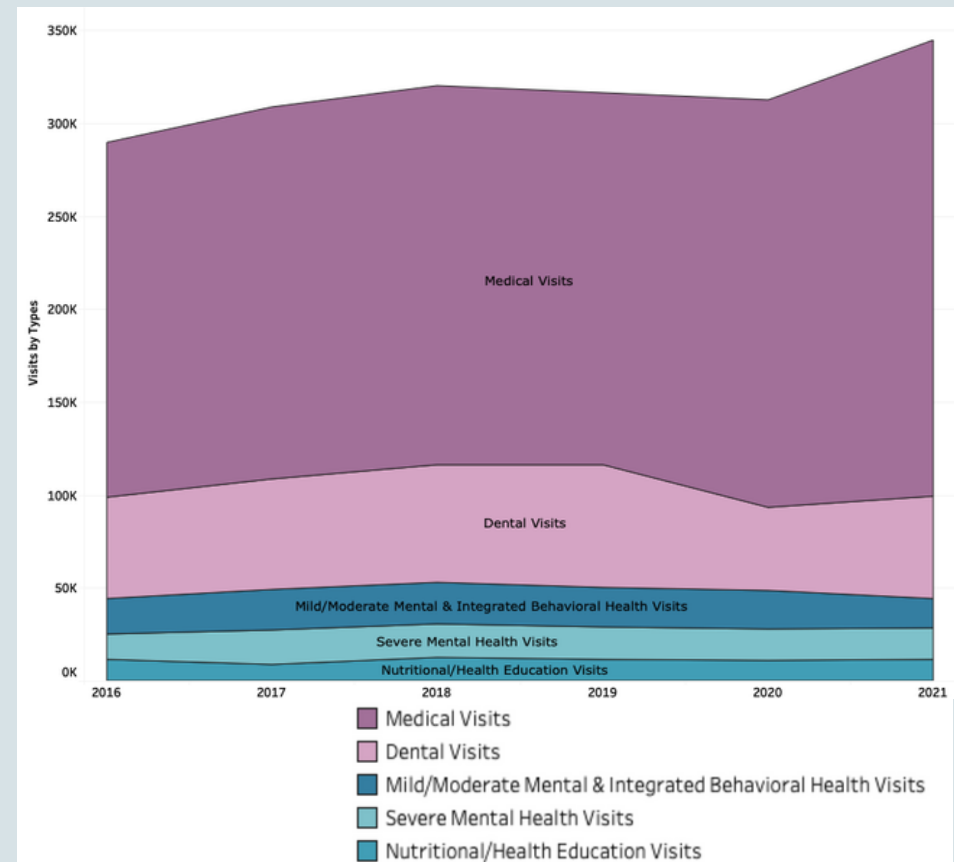
Medical visits increased by nearly 23% over the same five year period (45,537 additional visits) **23%**

Total Patient Visits

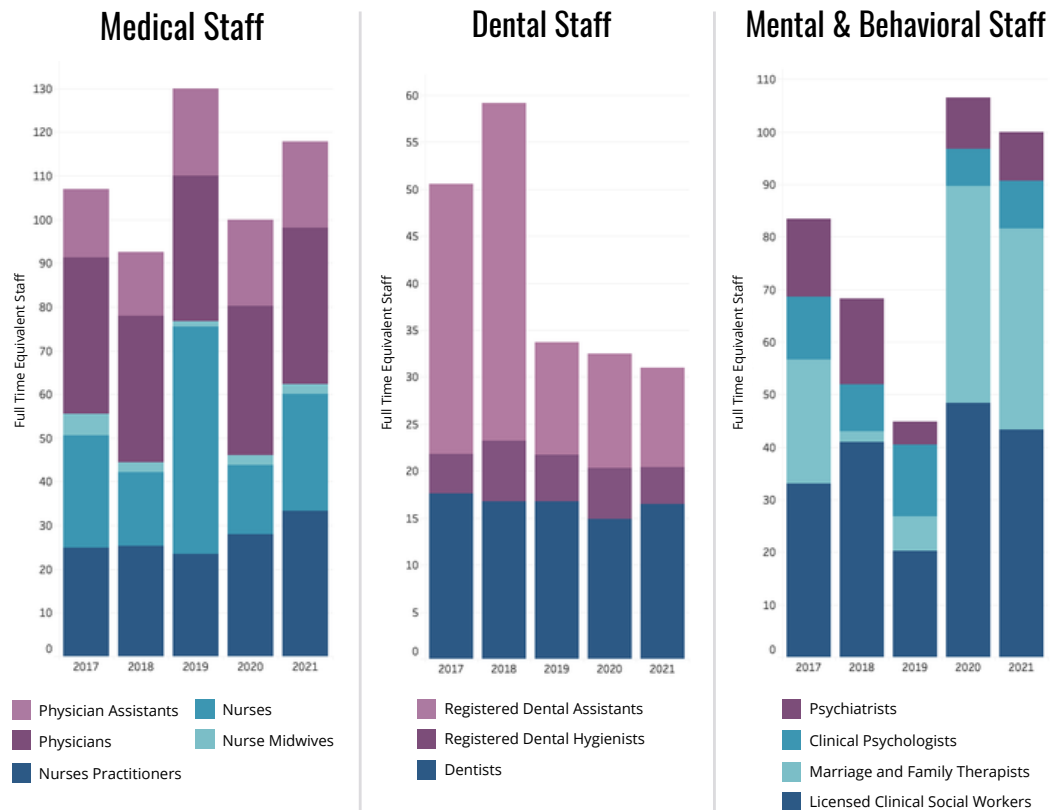

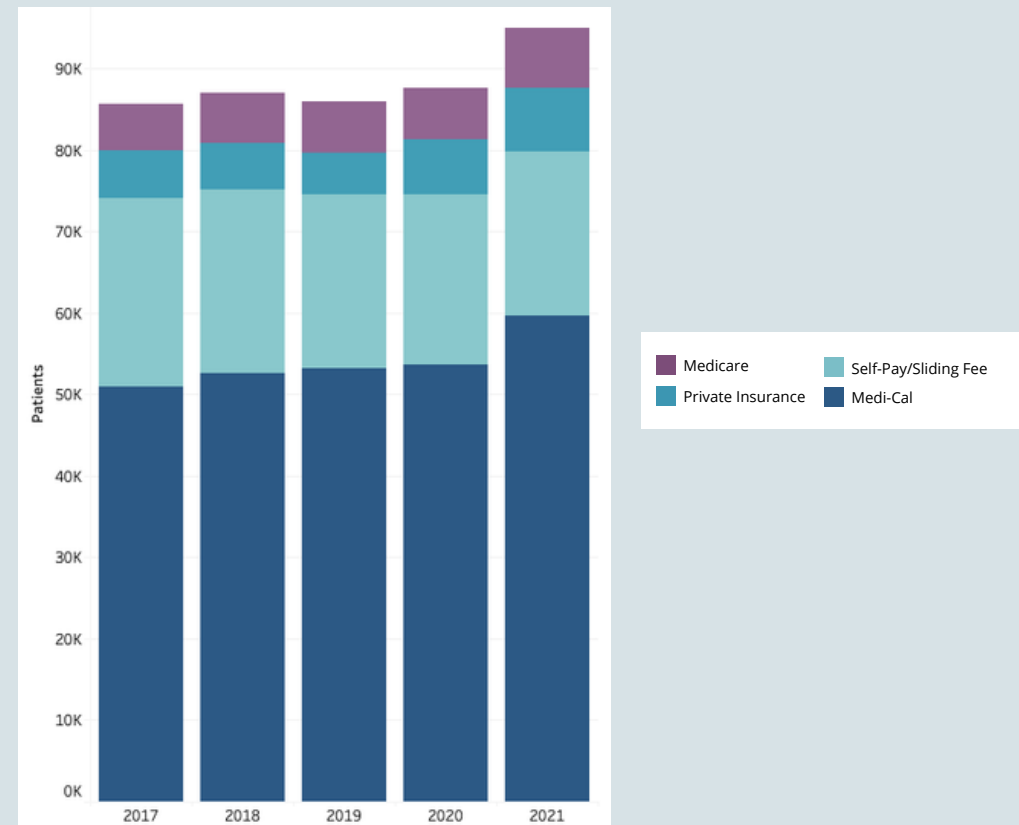
Patient Visits by Type of Care
